DECEMBER 06, 2011

Attempt Robbery:

An Attempt Robbery occurred at 7:50PM, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Bl. The suspect entered the business and shouted "This is a robbery" as he ordered everyone to get on the ground, then reached into his pocket and simulated he had a weapon. The suspect said he was joking and walked out of the business. The suspect appeared under the influence a controlled substance. This is an ongoing investigation.

December 08, 2011

Petty Theft:

A Petty Theft was reported at 6:45PM in the 5700 block of Rosemead Bl. The victim entered a local business with return items, as she pushed a shopping cart throughout the business. The victim was approached by a female, who asked her opinion on clothing and drew her away from her shopping cart. When the victim returned to her cart, she noticed her return items were missing. There were no reported witnesses at the time and the video surveillance could not be accessed at the time of the incident.

Petty Theft:

A Petty Theft was reported at 10:00AM, in the 5900 block of Temple City Bl. The victim is a manager at a local business. The victim said he could not locate his key to lock the business, so he had an employee lock the business for the evening. When the victim returned, he discovered approximately \$300.00 U.S. currency was missing from the business. The victim believes someone took his key and returned later to commit the theft. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.

December 09, 2011

Petty Theft:

A Petty Theft occurred at 3:00PM, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Dr. The victim parked his bicycle in a bike rack at a local business without locking the bicycle. When he returned, the bicycle was gone. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.

DECEMBER 13, 2011

Embezzlement: A Embezzlement was reported at 1:00PM in the 9500 block of Las Tunas Dr. The suspect was an employee of a local business. The suspect was seen on surveillance video scanning items, the placing money in her pocket. The suspect stole hundreds of dollars throughout a several month period. The suspect is a resident of the city of Temple City.

DECEMBER 15, 2011

Petty Theft: A Petty Theft occurred at 4:00PM in the 5600 block of Rosemead Bl. The suspects entered a local business and placed numerous items inside of their purses, then exited without paying for the items. The suspects were detained by store security and detained pending the arrival of deputies. There is surveillance video of the incident. The suspects are both residents of the city of Rosemead.

DECEMBER 19, 2011

Petty Theft: A Petty Theft occurred at 5:35PM in the 9600 block of Las Tunas Dr. The victim is a business owner, who had locked bicycles on display in front of his business. The neighboring business owner informed the victim, he saw someone steal one of the victim's bikes and ride away. The neighboring business video camera showed the suspect ride up to the bicycles on display, then cut the display lock and ride away on his bicycle. The suspect returned on foot a short time later and stole one of the victim's bikes from the display and rode away.

Petty Theft: A Petty Theft occurred between 3:39PM-3:43PM, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Dr. The victim used the restroom at a local business and forgot her purse when she exited. Approximately two minutes later, the victim returned to get her purse when she saw an employee in the restroom, and discovered \$200.00 U.S. currency missing from her purse. The victim confronted the employee, who denied taking the money. A video camera showed the victim exit the restroom, than the employee enter the restroom a short time later. Within minutes, the victim is seen reentering to the restroom and the employee is the only person in the area. When Deputies arrived the completed his shift and was gone for the day. Deputies were unable to contact the employee at the time of the report.

DECEMBER 21, 2011

Petty Theft: A Petty Theft occurred at 2:00PM in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Dr. The victim was shopping at a local business and left her purse inside of a shopping cart. Once the victim arrived home, she realized her purse was missing. A short time later, the victim was contacted by a male who said he found the purse. The victim's wallet was additionally recovered and turned into city hall. The victim was missing \$200.00 in U.S. currency, but recovered the majority of her property. There were no reported witnesses or video of the incident.

DECEMBER 23, 2011

Petty Theft: A Burglary Shoplifting occurred at 2:50PM in the 5600 block of Rosemead Bl. The suspects entered a local business and stole approximately six DVD videos. When a store security officer went to detain the suspects, they ran to a nearby vehicle and drove away. There is a witness and video surveillance of the theft. This is an ongoing investigation.

A Commercial Burglary occurred at 11:30PM in the 10100 block of Bogue St. The victim said someone cut a hole into the window of the administration office building and stole \$6.00 dollars from a desk. There were no reported witnesses, but there is possibly video of the incident.

A Vehicle Burglary between 5:00AM – 9:00AM in the 5600 block of Rosemead Bl. The victim is an employee at a local business. The victim parked her vehicle in the parking lot of her employer and went to work. When the victim returned, she saw her vehicle was broken into and items were stolen from the vehicle. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.

Shoplifting: Deputy Maclean arrested a MW/66 for Burglary Shoplifting at 1:00PM in the 5700 block of Rosemead Bl. The suspect entered a local business and stole clothing and other items. The suspect was confronted outside of the business by store security and returned some items, then ran from the scene. The suspect was captured a short time later by Deputies and positively identified by store security. The suspect was in possession of numerous brand new items with tags in his vehicle and no purchase receipts. There were witnesses and video surveillance of the incident. The suspect is a resident of the city of La Canada.
